- A handheld or mounted optical device used to enlarge the view of an object, aiding in the detailed inspection of instruments
- 3. Device to hold hinged instruments open.
- 5. Careful examination of instruments for function and cleanliness.
- Device used to verify that sterilant has made contact inside instrument sterile barrier
- document provided by a device manufacturer that provides instruction on how to use and properly reprocess the device
- The hollow channel inside a tube or instrument
